

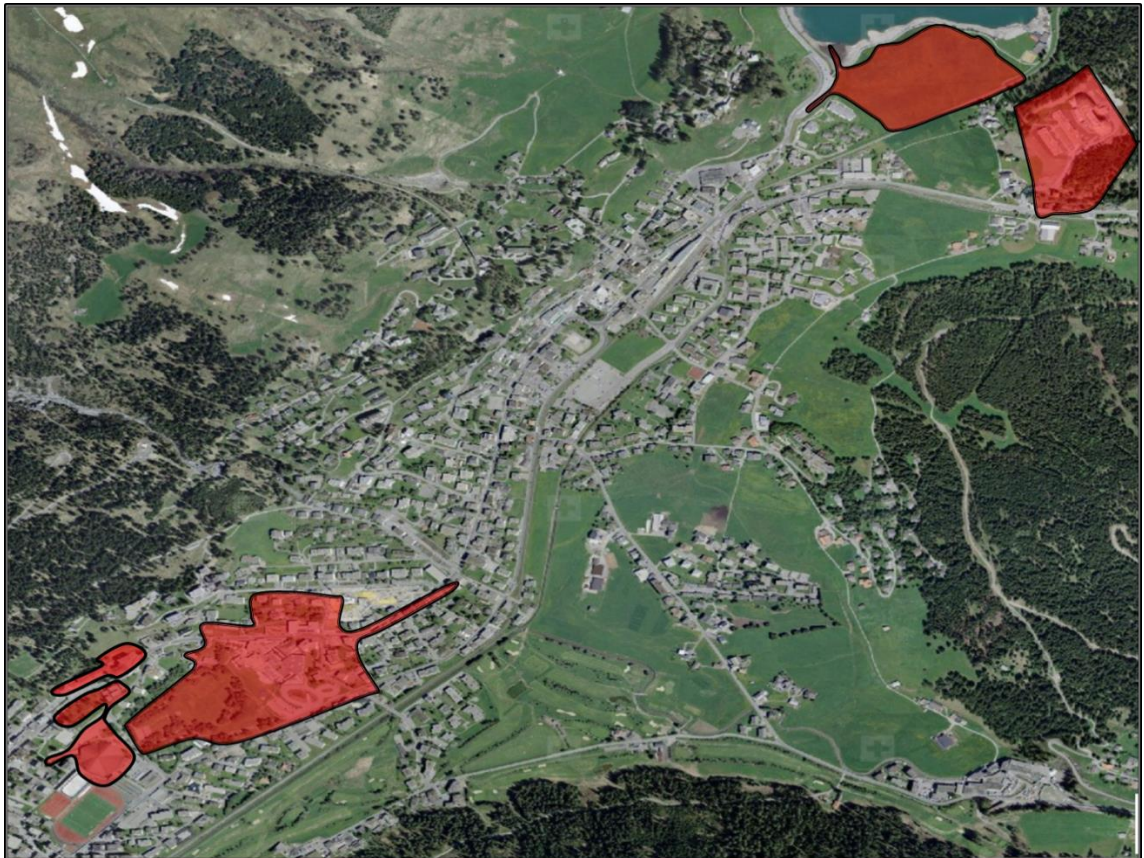


WEF 24 – Security zones

1 Security zones

The Cantonal Police Grisons decrees security zones, pursuant to Art. 2 and 9-22c, Police Act for the Canton Grisons (PolG; BR 613.000) as well as Art. 3, para. 6 of the Swiss Road Act (SVG; SR 741.01), to ensure security in the Municipality of Davos during the Annual Meeting of the World Economic Forum 2024.

1.1 The following areas in the municipality of Davos are declared as security zones:



- The area Congress Hotel, Hotel Hilton, Congress Center, Kurpark
- The area around Hotel Belvédère
- The area around Alpengold Hotel
- The area around Heliport Lago, lake parking lot and lakeside fields
- The area around the ice stadium

The boundaries of the security zones will be marked off by barriers.

1.2 The following persons are permitted to enter and remain in these zones with the appropriate documentation:

- Residents
- Organizers, accredited participants and service personnel of the World Economic Forum

- Police
- Security forces
- Persons transporting and picking up those attending the annual meeting
- Professional or trades people exercising any of their duties during this event
- Accredited media representatives within the areas allocated to them
- Members of operational organizations
- Representatives of various authorities
- Persons who can provide legitimate reasons for their presence (specifically hotel residents, workers, persons visiting doctors etc.)
- Persons with specific permits from the Cantonal Police for the Canton Grisons

1.3 The security zones may be subject to video surveillance.

1.4 This order enters into force on January 13, 2024 / 6:00 pm and remains in effect through January 21, 2024 / 8:00 am at the latest or upon removal of cordons or barriers and/or signs.

1.5 Police may take persons into custody and prosecute anyone illegally trying to enter the security zones or remaining therein.

2 Inspections

Access to Davos as well as the municipal area of Davos is subject to inspections. Persons entering the control and search zones or remaining therein are obliged to submit their clothing, containers or vehicles used by them to a search for such objects.

3 Flight noise

Please be aware that increased flight activity, especially from helicopters, for the period January 2 - January 27, 2024, is likely to result in increased flight noise primarily in the Landwasser and Prättigau valleys.

4 Preparations

Construction work starts on January 2, 2024, in order to implement the necessary security measures on time.

The Cantonal Police Grisons asks for your patience and understanding for the increased security measures by the police and its impact on residents and guests.
